# Message From Evangelistic Outreach

(Excerpt from Truth for Life Daily: Spurgeon Devotional October 8, 2023)

"Miraculous Catch of Fish"

Luke 5:4 "Put out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch."

We learn from this narrative *the necessity of human activity*. The catch of fish was miraculous, but neither the fisherman nor his fishing tackle were ignored; they all were used to take the fish. So, in the saving of souls, God works by means; and while the present operation of grace shall stand, God will be pleased by the foolishness of preaching to save those who believe. When God works without instruments, He is glorified; but He has selected this plan of human involvement as being that by which He is most magnified in the earth.

The means themselves can accomplish nothing. "Master, we toiled all night and took nothing!" What was the reason for this? Were they not experienced fisherman going about their business? They were not novices; they understood the work. Was the problem that they lacked skill? No. Were they lazy? No; they had worked. Did they lack perseverance? No; they had worked all night. Was there a lack of fish in the sea? Certainly not, for as soon as the Master came, they swam to the net in large numbers. What, then, is the reason? It is because there is no power in the means themselves apart from the presence of Jesus. Without Him we can do nothing. But with Christ we can do all things.

Christ's presence confers success. Jesus sat in Peter's boat, and His will, by a mysterious influence, drew the fish to the net. When Jesus is lifted up in His Church, His presence is the church's power-the shout of a king is in the midst of her. "I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to Myself." (John 12:32). Let us go out this morning on our work of soul-fishing, looking up in faith, and around us at the great opportunity. Let us work until night comes, and we will not labor in vain, for He who tells us to let down the net will fill it with fish.

# On Prayer by James Banks

Now sometimes we might mistakenly think that prayer has something to do with skill. Sometimes you hear someone who is very well meaning say "I don't have the Spiritual gift of prayer." But did you know that of all the spiritual gifts listed in Scripture, prayer is not among them? And there's an excellent reason for that. Prayer is meant for all of us. "Why Pray?" "Because you prayed!" "Bend down, O LORD, and listen!" Isaiah 36 and 37. That doesn't mean things will go our way every time we pray, but if we learn to pray proactively---making prayer our "first resort" and not "a last resort" ---we will or may see God do breathtaking things. He wants us to help us lift our eyes above our circumstances so that we can catch a glimpse of His goodness and love. He wants us to pray so that we will get to know Him---and that really is the best part about prayer. True prayer is about so much more than just request or answers---it's about a relationship with the One who will love and sustain us even when the answers don't seem to come.


