On Prayer by James Banks

Now sometimes we might mistakenly think that prayer has something to do with skill. Sometimes you hear someone who is very well meaning say "I don't have the Spiritual gift of prayer." But did you know that of all the spiritual gifts listed in Scripture, prayer is not among them? And there's an excellent reason for that. Prayer is meant for all of us. "Why Pray?" "Because you prayed!" "Bend down, O LORD, and listen!" Isaiah 36 and 37. That doesn't mean things will go our way every time we pray, but if we learn to pray proactively---making prayer our "first resort" and not "a last resort" ---we will or may see God do breathtaking things. He wants us to help us lift our eyes above our circumstances so that we can catch a glimpse of His goodness and love. He wants us to pray so that we will get to know Him---and that really is the best part about prayer. True prayer is about so much more than just request or answers---it's about a relationship with the One who will love and sustain us even when the answers don't seem to come.

Ever fasted over your finances?

Fasting enables you to take your eyes off the things of this world so you can focus on the Lord. The Bible addresses fasting for repentance, sorrow, deliverance, guidance, and help. There are different types, including fasting from foods, drinks, or certain activities. Done in humility and not to show off our righteousness, fasting strengthens us to overcome sin and draw closer to God.

Bethesda is currently experiencing some financial challenges. We know that there is nothing too big for God, Amen! We have an aging physical plant and while each of the items below, may seem like a big deal to us, this is not so with God:

- Roof Replacement
- Tile repair on 2nd floor
- Plumbing leak in Mechanical Room
- Lightbulb replacement in Sanctuary
- Exterior door replacement
- Projector replacement in Sanctuary

Whenever we abstain from something, we expose how strong our desire is for certain earthly things. By denying ourselves in this way, we clean out the soul, making room for God. This is why prayer goes hand-in-hand with fasting. For when you desire whatever-it-is you're fasting from, instead of turning to that thing, you turn to God in prayer. In feeling the pain of emptiness, you take time to be filled up with God.

Now this has been my experience. Whether seeking His will in financial decisions or dealing with financial pain, try fasting. Turn to Him. Only the Lord can satisfy our deepest longings.

I am calling on all of Bethesda to join us in a church-wide Fast from 6 am to 5 PM next Friday, May 3th. At 6 PM, we will come together via zoom for one hour of corporate prayer.
